NEW BUSINESS:

PEC Line replacement—The Board voted unanimously to put this issue before the club membership. Cost to replace PEC lines in the Auto Shop with copper is \$6500. The Paint Booth has copper lines. The motion to replace compromised PEC air lines in the shop with copper lines at a cost not to exceed \$6500 was made by Bob Janis and seconded by Tom Lundbom. Ballots were distributed.
