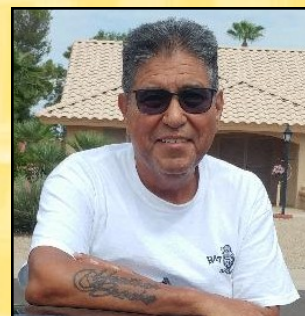
TOMMY MARÈS – NEW MEMBER

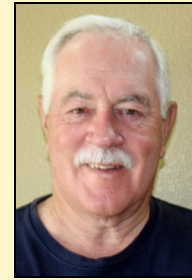

ember and the return of the "Cactus Derby" event by Herb Clark in February 2022, following the Car Show. Stay tuned.



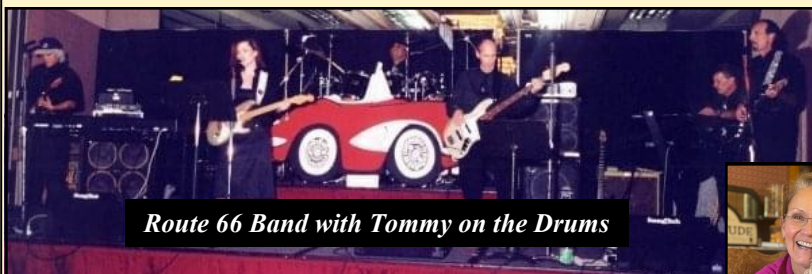

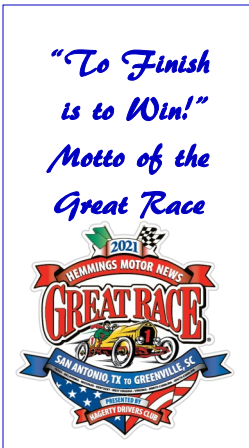

as we hear more about Zane, we will let you know via Group Works.

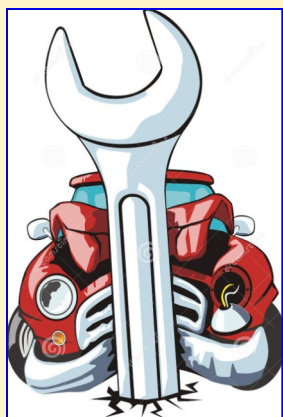

ARC 1959 T-Bird Restoration
Automotive/Restoration Club of SCW

The restoration of this T-Bird was a joint venture with the Automotive/Restoration Club of Sun City West (ARC) members mentoring local high school students. One of ARC's missions is to work with youth as we pass our knowledge to another generation. The T-Bird was originally donated to Met Martin Auto Museum who in turn donated it to ARC with the objective of restoring it and using it as a teaching tool. ARC is a 501 (C)(3) organized to work with youth and raise funds for charities. ARC has worked with Make-A-Wish, Firefighters Charities, American Cancer Society, Relay for Life, Red Cross, Alzheimer Association as well as the Dysart School District. While ARC has nearly 700 members, it is dedicated to advancing the car hobby through a balance of well-equipped facilities, a variety of activities designed to meet members' needs, providing youth and adult training and assistance, social events, field trips, hosting a top rated car show in the West Valley and working with other charities.

The saga of the ARC T-Bird closed on Wednesday, June 30th, as it departed for its new home base in Los Angeles, CA. We did not make back the \$\$ we put into the bird, but it did pay us back some of our investment as a teaching tool for the Dysart and Sunrise Mountain Auto Tech classes and for some of the ARC mem-

bers who touched the car during its stay with us.

The Alex Manos group who bought the car, as is, no warranty, were straight up to deal with from start to finish.

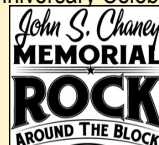

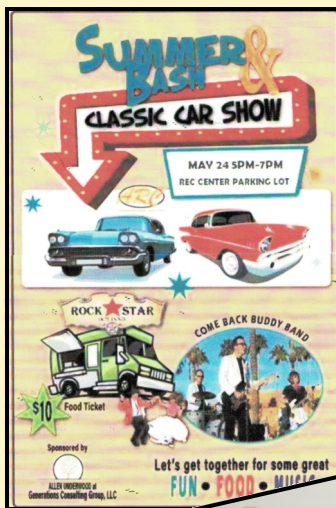

NEW LIFE DIRECTION AND PURPOSE FOR ME

The Back Story to Behind the Wheel



After 45 years of intense involvement in all things Porsche, I have taken an off-ramp and made a 90-degree turn toward the British side of the English Channel. I have owned eight different Porsches, participated in many Porsche Club of America track days, auto-crosses, rallies, concours and social events. I have served as a Porsche Club Officer and as a National Porsche Club Concours Judge. It was very often life and time consuming, but it was also great fun, for sure. However, I do believe in recent years Porsche has become just another Motor Car Company selling lots of SUV's, Tesla knock-offs and \$150K+ track day sports cars to wealthy snobs. So, I'm out .

We had a 1998 Jaguar XJ8 which was turned in for

a European Tourist Delivery BMW in 2001. My wife, Elaine, never quite forgave me for parting with her Jag even though driving around in Europe for six weeks in the Bimmer was great fun and most enjoyable. Anyway, after 20 some years and four BMWs and a Mercedes, we returned to the Jaguar fold with a 2021 XF Saloon (English for sedan) last Spring. The XF competes with BMW 5-series, Mercedes E-class and Audi A6 plus other mid-size sport sedans. The Jaguar is more delicate and refined yet is much more agile and fun to drive than its German counterparts, more BMW like than any of the others. The Jag is some 500 pounds lighter, made mostly of aluminum, and \$10K cheaper to buy, a no brainer for me.

Recently, while searching

the internet, I just happened onto a 2014 Jaguar F-Type V8 S sports car which was a one-owner, Arizona car sold and serviced at the local Jaguar dealership in Scottsdale. It was on consignment at a specialty dealer shop. The original owner had surgery and had not been able to drive the car for two years before deciding to part with it. I made them a "Let's just trade keys" offer for my 30-year-old Porsche 911 and the Jag F-Type and it was accepted. We shook hands and the deal was done. Did I really mean to do this, I asked myself? Well and Hell, yes!

The F-Type is a 22-year upgrade from the 1992 Porsche and sounds like a British Corvette. It has a 5-liter, supercharged V8 (look out Mustang GTs) and an 8-

speed ZF automatic gear box. I am amazed how modern yet how visceral the car is to drive. I am having to relearn about understeer with front mounted engines after years of driving tail happy Porsches with the engine hanging out back.

Elaine was/is hugely supportive of this new direction so it is a win-win situation all round. So now, there you have it, within a period of four months, our garage which has housed two fine German automobiles for the last 20 years is now the home for two fine British vehicles from Coventry. Life is good!

MOTION UP FOR A VOTE AT THE SEPT. 21ST MEETING AT 2PM IN THE SOCIAL HALL

The ARC Board has approved the replacement of lift #2 and will be seeking member approval for that expenditure at the September 21, 2021 meeting.

The red #2, two-post lift is unsafe and must be replaced before we drop a car or hurt someone. It has proved to be unstable with bigger vehicles when higher up and the holding

dogs do not always engage properly. Therefore, it was proposed to the ARC Board that a new lift be purchased as a replacement.

The final cost of the new lift is expected to be \$8,252.69 and would be purchased from Doehrman. The proposed lift is a rotary lift and holds up

to 10K lbs. This price includes installation and comes with an offer of \$500. for old lift #2. ARC could choose to advertise and sell the old lift for maybe \$1,000 to possibly \$1,500.



A Motion will be made at the September 21st meeting to purchase a new lift at a cost not to exceed

\$10,000. (The higher amount is in case there is an unforeseen issue that arises.)

After the Motion is presented, there will be discussion and then a secret ballot vote. The results of the vote will be announced at the conclusion of the meeting.
