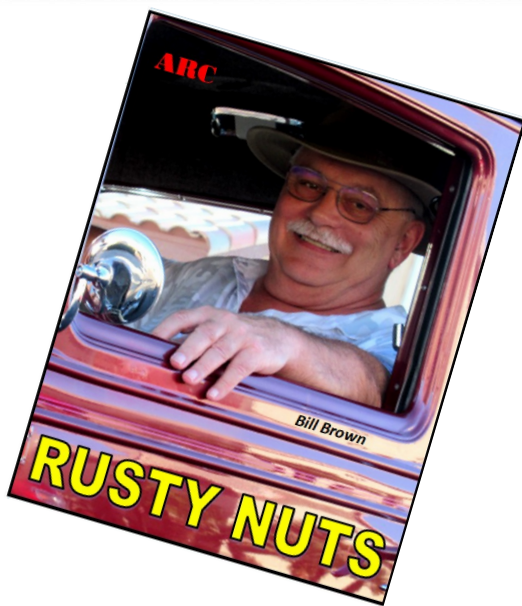
Hope everyone had a Merry Christmas and a safe 'n Happy New Year... First, we need someone to step up to take over organizing the Golf

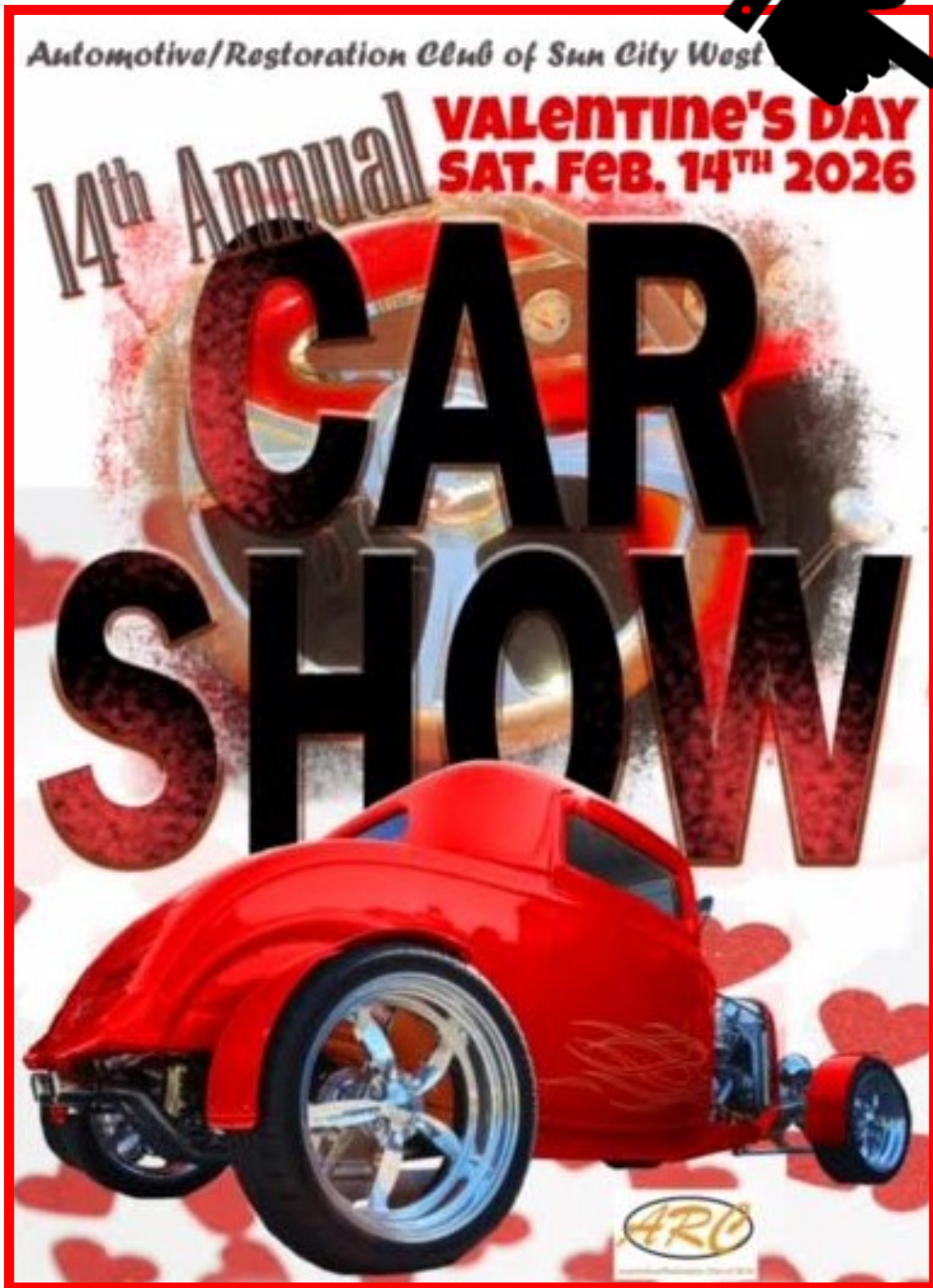

all new American Eagle 4 wheel drive. The first modern crossover vehicle with that drivetrain (came out about August 1979). Another interesting job was working as a flat bed trailer operator on the roads around Kenosha WI—interesting evnts!. He ended his working career with Abbot Laboratories in charge of maintaining Clean Rooms, yes, all suited up.. *A very important position in the pharmaceutical field.*

His most memorable trip by car? Attending The Wisconsin Lake Dalton Car Show. Automotion, it's a *Monster Meet* of a Car Show. 1000's of cars from Trucks, Classic, Muscle, Vintage to Hollywood. His time racing? Both Track and Street! Interesting time when Officer Friendly offered to take speeds with his Radar Unit for the guys racing on the roadway of the M Stuz Parkway (from Chicago to Milwaukee) where a 1/4 mile was marked off.

His Hot Rod is set up a bit different: the differential is from a 60's Jaguar, take a look at the photo below, see the in-board discs? Neat. The power to weight ratio is a bit offset with the light body and motor and it needs stopping power now! The Front End is a straight axle so care must be taken



over speed bumps in parking lots. The Rear of the car can absorb the shock but not the front!

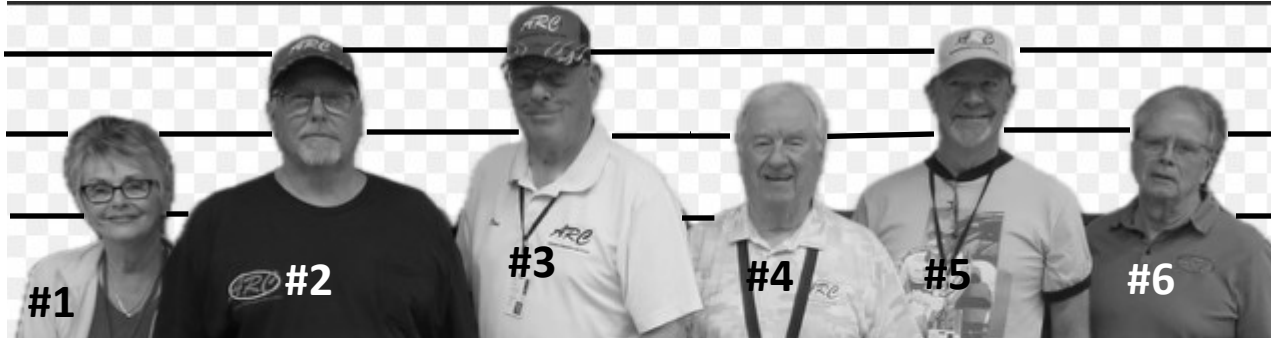

What's so special about a Muncie Transmission? Other than being produced in Munchie, Indiana? Go Hoosiers!

Lots, it 's a heavy duty multi-standard for car enthusiasts that needed a better transmission for their application. Also, *The explosion of muscle cars in the 60's to 70's needed 'em.*

1931 Chevrolet
Hard Top Coupe
355 CI 4BBL
4 Speed Muncie

They came in 3 configurations, the M20, 21 (63-74) and M22 (67-74). Cruise, Race (with High RPMs) and Heavy Duty for — 400 HP and up?? The last one, have you ever ridden in a hi-performance vehicle and complained how noisy the trans was? Odds are you were sitting next to the “Rock Crusher” M22 just built to take it and to heck with the decibels! The 20 is a Street Friendly option and the last—more Top End Speed for you Speedsters!!
