Ron Rada: ARC Building Phase III

The final plans have been received by RCSCW and the initial 2 bids are forthcoming. Pledges and donations now total over \$140,000.

The General Membership will be advised of the costs after the bids are received. A ballot to vote will be sent electronically from RCSCW to members in the next couple of weeks. ARC Members will have a weeks' notice before receiving the electric ballot from RCSCW and will then have a week to vote thereafter.

The revised ARC Bylaws have been signed by the ARC President, Craig Landers, and are now in effect.

New Business:

Mike Kent – Garage Tours

Mike would like to institute a series of monthly tours to private garages in SCW. He will post a clipboard in the Shop for sign ups for both members offering to open their garages as well as those wanting to attend the tours. Probably limit to around 12 participants to include the tour, a Poker Run and possibly lunch. If successful, there may be interest in going outside SCW to tour garages.

Gary Masak: The ARC 14th annual car show was held on February 14, 2026. 420 cars attended. It went extremely well due to the efforts of everyone involved. After 14 years, Gary announced his retirement as Car Show head but will help guide the next person to assume his duties. Starting 2027 no ARC cars will be allowed to Show, even though not judged.

Craig Landers: The 2026 Dream Car winner is Maria Schwager, Cab Bergschneider won 2nd prize of \$1,000.

Linda and Steve Victor: The annual American Cancer Society's Relay for Life of the Sun Cities will be held on Sunday, February 22 at Beardsley Park from 3-7:30 pm. Steve asked for ARC cars to attend a mini car show with a \$20 fee. Cars should be at the park by 2:30 pm. ARC has a team of 20 this year. There will be a victory lap for survivors at 4 pm, Pizza dinner at 5 pm, lighting of 500 luminaries and closing at 6:30 pm. Randy Robinson donated \$700 at the meeting by putting the cash in a bucket and asking ARC members to pass it through the audience. \$1,335.00 was collected and donated to Relay for Life.
